Gentlemen:

You have asked for Applicants' estimate of hearing dates for the remainder of this case. As of the present, there are five issues which have yet to be litigated before the Licensing Board:

Issue 1 (Emergency Planning)  
Issue 6 (Standby Liquid Control System Initiation)  
Issue 8 (Hydrogen Control)  
Issue 14 (In-Core Thermocouples)  
Issue 15 (Steam Erosion)

The Staff's motion for summary disposition on Issue 13 (turbine missiles) is currently pending.

It is our current best estimate that Issues 14 and 15 will be disposed of by motions for summary disposition. We would estimate that these motions will be filed sometime within the next four to six months. Issues 6 and 8 should be resolved without the necessity for hearing based on rulemaking proceedings which are currently pending. The Staff should be in the best position to estimate when these proceedings will be completed.


