Gentlemen:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter of June 13, 1983, which includes a detailed description of the exercise scenario outline and sequence of events for the Big Rock Point Emergency Exercise scheduled for July 25 and 26, 1983. This meets our request for submittal 45 days prior to the exercise.

The scenario outline appears sufficient to test the adequacy of timing and content of implementing procedures and methods, test emergency equipment and communications networks, test (simulated) the public notification system, and ensure that emergency organizations personnel are familiar with their duties. This meets the requirements of 10 CFR 50, Appendix E.IV.F. Please ensure my staff will receive the complete scenario package at least 20 days prior to the exercise.

Mr. James Patterson of my staff will be the NRC Team Leader assigned to observe licensee performance during this exercise.

DOCKET 50-155 - LICENSE DPR-6 -
BIG ROCK POINT PLANT - EMERGENCY
PLAN EXERCISE SCENARIO (45 DAY LETTER)

NRC letter dated January 12, 1982 requested a detailed description of an emergency plan exercise scenario and anticipated actions to be submitted 45 days prior to the date of each exercise. Our next exercise, presently scheduled for July 25 and 26, will involve full participation by State, local and Federal agencies. Scenario revisions discussed with NRC staff representatives Messrs Axelson (on May 25, 1983) and Patterson on (June 8, 1983) have resulted in a slight delay in the submittal of this scenario.

Final calculations may change the attached scenario somewhat, however, appropriate revisions will be incorporated within the requested 20 day response package. It should be noted that the attached scenario is not considered a credible sequence of events. The scenario was developed as such to exercise all four phases of the Emergency Plan. It reflects, as much as possible, realistic situations however. It is Consumers Power Company's position that any credible accident scenario would not exercise the four phases specified as Unusual Event, Alert, Site Area Emergency and General Emergency.
