This is in response to your letter dated May 27, 1983, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), a list of all contractors who have been awarded contracts since 1979.


Following receipt of your request, Ms. Robinson telephoned your office to seek clarification of the scope of your request. During a telephone conversation on June 13, 1983, you clarified that, among other things, the scope of your request does not include information pertaining to interagency agreements. As a result of that conversation, the NRC Division of Contracts has provided a computer printout that contains the names of all NRC contractors, and the numbers and titles of all awarded NRC contracts, since 1979.

The requested list is being made available at the NRC Public Document Room (PDR), 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20555, for your inspection and copying. The list will be filed in PDR folder FOIA-83-295 under your name. Copies of the NRC contracts are filed among separate PDR folders.

There is no charge for inspecting records at the PDR. The charge for copying records maintained in the PDR is five cents (\$0.05) per page, as specified in 10 CFR 9.14(a).

If you do not wish to visit the PDR to inspect or copy this list, you may obtain a copy by calling (202-634-3273) or writing directly to the PDR to request a copy. Upon your agreement to pay the copying charges, the PDR will arrange for the list to be copied by a private contractor servicing the PDR. You will be billed by the private contractor for the copying charges, plus tax and postage.
