Dear Mrs. Doherty:

This is in response to your letter dated June 30, 1983, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), copies of Request for Proposal (RFP) No. RS-ORM-83-464, the successful bidder's proposal, and the resulting contract. This confirms the information relayed during the telephone conversation between you and Linda Robinson on July 7, 1983.

The NRC cannot provide copies of the requested successful bidder's proposal and the contract at this time because the NRC has not yet awarded the contract. The anticipated contract award date is September 13, 1983.

A copy of the requested RFP is being placed in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR), 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20555, for public inspection and copying. The RFP will be filed in PDR folder FOIA-83-377 under your name.

The charge for obtaining copies of records maintained at the PDR is five cents (\$0.05) per page, as specified in 10 CFR 9.14(a).

You may obtain a copy of the RFP by calling (202-634-3273) or writing directly to the PDR to request a copy. Upon your agreement to pay the copying charges, the PDR will arrange for the RFP to be copied by a private contractor servicing the PDR. You will be billed by the private contractor for the copying charges, plus tax and postage.

Inasmuch as the NRC routinely makes copies of contracts available at the PDR for public inspection, you may obtain a copy of the subject contract from the PDR shortly after the contract is awarded. You may also submit a separate FOIA request to this office for the subject proposal after the contract is awarded.
