Dear Mr. Felton:

On February 10, 1983, Phyllis Girouard of Chadron, Ne. wrote to you on our behalf requesting a copy of the application for a permit to mine uranium, submitted by Wyoming Fuels. The request was made under the Freedom of Information Act.

Since so much time has elapsed we are assuming the request has been forgotten or has been denied. If the permit has been denied, will you please inform us which section under the F O I A requires the entire document to be exempt. Also will you please inform us of the appeal procedure.

We will be pressing for delays in hearings, issuing of permits, etc. until our expert witnesses have had ample time to review these documents and make necessary comments.

Additionally, we request that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission hold a hearing on Wyoming Fuel Co's application for a permit to mine uranium. We further request that the hearing be held in the Crawford area.
