Dear Sir:

This is in response to your Notice of Violation which was sent to Calvin College on 1 February 1991. We have taken note of the violations, and the following steps have been and are being taken to bring us into full compliance with the Conditions of our License.

1. With respect to License Condition No. 13(C) that each sealed source in our possession be tested for leakage and/or contamination at intervals not to exceed six months:
  - a. Leak tests are now scheduled to be performed at intervals not to exceed six months.
  - b. A listing of the responsibilities of the Radiation Safety Officer at Calvin College, along with the calendar schedule for performing the required duties, is being prepared. This list will be placed in the files of the Radiation Safety Officer, and will be appropriately labelled so that such responsibilities will not be overlooked again.
  - c. We are now in compliance with License Condition No. 13(C).
2. With respect to License Condition No. 18 that the Radiation Safety Officer keep an inventory of the amount of radioactive materials presently possessed:
  - a. The inventory of radioactive materials is currently being updated.
  - b. The responsibility for keeping the inventory up to date will be included in the listing referred to in 1.b. above.
  - c. We will be in full compliance with License condition No. 18 by 15 March 1991.
