

Dear Mr. Allan:

This transmission confirms the telephone report of July 12, 1983, by A. Piemontese to J. McCann of your staff, regarding surveillance testing of Containment Radiation Monitors. The "B" monitor was out of service and the surveillance test period was exceeded for the "A" monitor. The "A" monitor was in service, when required, during this period and was successfully tested upon discovery of the overdue test.

This condition is considered reportable in accordance with Technical Specification 6.9.1.8.b, and additional information regarding circumstances of the incident and corrective actions to be taken will be provided in the fourteen day follow-up report.
