FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST


In the Federal Register, January 29, 1957 (Volume 22, No. 19, page 548), an announcement is given for the Standards for Protection against Radiation, Title 10, CFR, Part 20. In the lead-off sentence the announcement refers to the Commission's issuance in "July 1955" for public comment proposed regulations or rules pertaining to standards of radiation protection for 10 CFR 20. I would like a copy of the totality of what the Commission referred to - whatever it all was that the Commission had issued (published) in July 1955 for public comment, including all prefatory statements and explanations, the proposed regulations or rules, and all appendices. Please send the material by telefax to my telefax at 49-8158-7117, and I will pay for the telefax cost. I assume that probably the material referred to in the Commission's 1957 announcement was published in the Federal Register in July 1955, but perhaps not.

I am a citizen of the United States, presently residing in Germany. Also, it is my understanding that the Freedom of Information Act requires the NRC is supply the request document within 10 days. I have made a

request for the material earlier in a letter to Ms. Elizabeth J. Yeates, Public Document Branch to the attention of Mr. Tom Smith of the Public Document room. However, after several days I received in the post a note from Mr. Smith that indicates that the requested material has not been found in the Public Document Room office. I therefore ask formally under the Freedom of Information Act for a prompt compliance with my request according to the law of the FOIA.

As the NRC is the logical Government agency to have taken custody of the records relating to the formation and setting of Radiation Protection Standards, when the Atomic Energy Commission was abolished, to form the NRC and the DOE, I believe that my request for information ought to be submitted to your office.
