SUBJECT: PROPOSED LICENSE TO EXPORT NUCLEAR COMPONENTS
TO SWEDEN (XCOM0783)

On July 13, 1983 Exxon Nuclear Company, Inc., applied for a license to export tie plate assemblies and their associated hardware, valued at \$40,000, to Sweden for installation in the Barsebaeck I Nuclear Power Reactor. These are replacement parts for parts originally exported under NRC License XCOM0369. The applicant has requested expeditious processing of the license application as some of these tie plates are urgently required for repair of in-use fuel assemblies.

The staff has concluded that the proposed export meets the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act, as amended, and would not be inimical to the common defense and security of the United States.

In view of the above considerations, the staff issued the license without the normal 15-day waiting period.
