

Inspection Summary

Inspection Conducted April 1-5, 1991 (Report 50-298/91-06)

Areas Inspected: Routine, unannounced inspection of the licensee's physical security program. The areas inspected within the physical security program included management effectiveness; access control--personnel; access control--packages; training and qualification of security officers; protected area (PA) barriers; security program audit; records and reports; testing and maintenance; access control--vehicles; and followup on previously identified inspection findings.

Results: Within the program areas inspected, one violation was identified in the area of personnel access control. The violation was corrected before the inspector left the site; therefore, documented corrective action will not be solicited of the licensee.

The security program at CNS appears to be properly managed and receives the support of plant management. The inspector identified several significant

areas of improvement in the security program. The improvements are addressed in paragraph 3.

The security force appears to be properly trained and motivated. The security staff is constantly seeking program improvement, and this attitude is apparent in all aspects of the CNS program. The inspector expressed some concern about the depth of the audits of the background investigation program.
