3. Is the gunsight or weapon labelled as required?
4. If the customer no longer possesses the gunsight, how did he dispose of it? Was it transferred to a specific licensee as required?
5. Has a leak test sample been submitted to Nite-Site as required? Does the general licensee have a record of leak test result? (not applicable to Leadership Keys' customers)
