Dear. Mr. Ronald Perry:

The Chicago office of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has begun inspections relative to HVAC construction activities by The Zack Company at the Midland and Clinton Nuclear Plant sites. Similar NRC inspections of The Zack Company's activities at their corporate office in Cicero, Illinois and at the LaSalle County Nuclear Power Generating Station were previously completed. Although the majority of your concerns related to Zack activities at their corporate office and these have been pursued by the NRC, we recognize that you may have other concerns which deal directly with Zack's onsite activities at Midland and Clinton.

Accordingly, this letter solicits from you any specific firsthand knowledge of either hardware or programmatic deficiencies which could adversely affect installed HVAC systems or components at either the Midland or Clinton facilities.

If you do have such information, we would greatly appreciate your prompt reply. In this regard, please call Mr. Frank Hawkins (312/932-2500) of my staff.
