This is in reply to your letter of June 24, 1983 concerning the non-compliance items noted during the routine inspection of our facility on June 6, 1983 by your D.R. Gibbons.

ITEM 1

The annual dosimeter check has been conducted. (copy enclosed)
Hereafter, this check will be done annually per 10 CFR 34.33 (c).
Full compliance is effective immediately.

ITEM 2

Notice of termination dosages has been sent to NRC headquarters per 10 CFR 20.408 (b) (copy enclosed). Every effort shall be made toward timely submittal in the future. Full compliance is effective immediately.

ITEM 3

The DOT required markings and labels are being applied or acquired. They will be maintained in good order on all transport containers. Full compliance will be achieved within 30 days.

We trust this is complete and puts us back in compliance with NRC regulations.

As requested of Mr. D.R. Gibbons during the inspection, we would appreciate two more copies each of parts 10 CFR 19, 20, 30 and 34 for our reference. We have some additional men who will need these for reference.
