This letter provides our response to NRC Violation 416/83-19-01 transmitted by your letter of May 26, 1983.

I. ADMISSION OR DENIAL OF THE ALLEGED VIOLATION

Personnel involved failed to comply with procedure governing the subject activity.

III. THE CORRECTIVE STEPS WHICH HAVE BEEN TAKEN AND THE RESULTS ACHIEVED

Operating personnel were reinstructed on the requirement of initialling night orders.

IV. CORRECTIVE STEPS WHICH WILL BE TAKEN TO AVOID FURTHER VIOLATIONS

The Operations Superintendent will periodically review the night orders to ensure they are being initialled by required personnel. Disciplinary action will be taken against persons involved in repeat non-compliances.

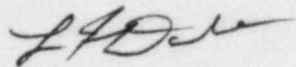
