NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation

During an NRC inspection conducted on June 25-28, 1991, a violation of NRC requirements was identified. In accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C (1991), the violation is listed below:

10 CFR Part 26, Appendix A, Subpart B, Section 2.3, requires, in part, that as a minimum, supervisors, coworkers, and relatives of the individual being tested under the fitness-for-duty program shall not perform any collection, assessment, or evaluation procedures.

Contrary to the above, between January 1990 and June 1991 security officers were assigned duties in regard to sample collection while their coworkers (other security officers) were selected test individuals.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VII).

Although Section 2.201 requires you to submit to this office, within 20 days of your receipt of this Notice, a written statement of explanation, we note that this violation had been corrected and those actions were reviewed and found adequate by the inspector. Therefore, no response with respect to this matter is required.
