SUBJECT: REVIEW OF THE LILCO TRANSITION PLAN

We appreciate your prompt review of the LILCO Transition Plan which you forwarded with your June 23, 1983 memorandum. A copy of your review was transmitted to the Long Island Lighting Company. On July 28, 1983, LILCO transmitted to NRC and to FEMA, Revision 1 pages to the LILCO Transition Plan which provided responses to FEMA concerns.

In accordance with Section II.4 of the November 1, 1980 NRC/FEMA Memorandum of Understanding, we request that you review Revision 1 to the LILCO Transition Plan and provide your findings by September 30, 1983. You should also be prepared to offer expert testimony on the revised plan at the evidentiary hearing.
