
This letter follows up on my conversation of November 23, 1994 with Mr. Thor Oberg of your office, concerning two beta gauges (manufactured by Ohmart) belonging to Scott Paper. These beta gauges were Kr-85 units, with a original strength (Sept, 1980) of 1200 mCi. I reported the accidental movement of these two (2) beta gauges off-site. During our leaving of Scott Plaza Three, contractors disassembled two small research paper machines, accidentally moving the gauges as part of the machines. The contractor, though told of the gauges, assumed that they had been removed and moved the machines. The equipment was moved to a secured Scott warehouse four miles away. The beta gauges were immediately located and the manufacturer technical representative called in to check the units and prepare them for shipment back to the manufacturer. After notification of the NRC, the units were shipped back to the manufacturer.

Attached is a copy of the bill of lading that was used to ship the gauges. We had waited for the NRC to clarify any questions before we shipped the gauges. It has been verified that the gauges have been received by Ohmart Corporation. To ensure that this does not happen again, we have taken the following steps:

- * Arranged with Ohmart to dispose of one beta gauge, as it was decided it was not needed.
- * Drafted a procedure emphasizing the regulatory restrictions concerning radioactive sources and the role of the Radiation Safety Officer to be included in the safety/health/environmental manual.
- * Once the beta gauge is received, it will be labeled "Do Not Move Without Written Approval of Radiation Safety Officer"
- * Include in the periodic safety and health training, appropriate training on handling of radioactive sources.
