This supplemental agreement of settlement entered into this 26th day of Aug 1983 between the United States of America (hereinafter called "the Government"), represented by the Contracting Officer, and Chromacolour Lab, Inc., (hereinafter called "the Contractor").

Witnesseth That:

Whereas, the Contractor and the Government have entered into Contract No. NRC-10-82-392, under date of March 5, 1982 which, together with any and all amendments, changes, modifications, and supplements thereto, is hereinafter referred to as "the contract"; and

Whereas, the termination for default clause of the contract provides that the performance of work thereunder may, at the option of the Government, be terminated by the Government in whole, whenever such termination is determined to be for the best interest of the Government and that the Contractor and the Contracting Officer may agree upon the whole or any part of the amount or amounts to be paid to the Contractor by reasons of such termination; and

Whereas, by notice of termination dated October 25, 1982 the Government advised the Contractor of the termination of the contract at the option of the Government;

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the document referenced in block 8, as heretofore changed, remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

Now therefore, the parties hereto agree as follows:

Article 1 - The contractor hereby unconditionally waives any claim against the Government by reason of termination of the contract and, except as set forth below, releases it from any and all obligation arising under the contract or by reason of its termination; and the Government agrees that all obligations arising under the contract or by reason of its termination shall be deemed to be concluded.


Article 2 - Notwithstanding any other provisions of this agreement, the following rights and liabilities of the parties under the contract are hereby reserved.

- (a) all rights and liabilities, if any, of the parties under the Renegotiation Act of 1951.
- (b) all rights and liabilities, if any, of the parties under those clauses inserted in the contract because of the requirements of statutes and Executives Orders, including, without limitations, any applicable clauses relating to the following topics: labor law, contingent fees, domestic articles, employment of liens, and "officials not to benefit."

The total amount of this contract is decreased by \$19,889.25 to \$8,606.90.
