In response to the above reference, Beth Israel Hospital has taken every precaution available to see that these violations will not recur. We are very much concerned about our Management Control System. Our new Radiation Safety Officer will be responsible to assure we comply in all respects to the criteria contained in our Radioactive Materials License. He will report directly to the Chairman of the Radiation Safety Committee and the committee. The Radiation Safety Committee will focus its attention to all Radiation Safety.

Item:

- A- Missing Exposure Reports
Missing exposure reports for the months of February, March, April, August - 1981 have been found and copies are submitted as evidence of this fact.
- B.1.a,- Dose Calibrator Calibrations
Dose calibrators will be calibrated in accordance with procedures contained in Appendix D, section 2, of Regulatory Guide 10.8. Weekly meetings are being held with the Department supervisor to assure protocol is followed.
- B.2- Protection surveys of the Nuclear Medicine areas will be performed on a weekly basis with all records maintained in the Nuclear area. The Radiation Safety Officer has been checking weekly to assure all records are correct and up to date.


B.3- Medical Isotopes Committee

The Radiation Safety Committee will replace the Medical Isotopes Committee. This committee will co-ordinate the use of byproduct material throughout the institution and supervise the Hospital's Radiation Safety Program. Meetings have been held on the following dates: August 11, 1982, October 6, 1982. The next scheduled meeting is January 5, 1983. This committee will meet on a quarterly basis.

Also enclosed is a copy of a list of all Regulatory Requirements which is mounted on the wall of the Nuclear Medicine area. An inservice program has been instituted by our Radiation Safety Officer to assure all personnel are aware of their responsibilities to this License Program.
