Dear Mr. Porter:

This is to confirm our conversation earlier today concerning a radiation survey of our office.

We understand that your fee will be \$85 per hour and you expect to be able to complete the survey and a report for approximately \$600.

As we discussed, our goals for this survey and report are as follows:

1. To assure that personnel in our office are not being exposed to contamination and the area where the Troxler gauge was stored is safe and suitable for normal office use.
2. To confirm to the extent possible that the gauge was not leaking while it was stored in our office.
3. To comply with Paragraph E on Page 3 of the order from the NRC (enclosed) which references 10 CFR 30.36(c)(1)(v), 40.42(c)(1)(v) and 70.38(c)(1)(v).
4. To conduct a similar radiation survey of our off-site storage location at 9th and Poplar Streets to confirm that the gauge is not there.


