License Amendment on the TMI-1 Steam Generators

On February 2, 1983, the licensee requested a license amendment to permit operation of the TMI-1 steam generators after repair by approved methods other than plugging (i.e., sealing tubes to upper tube sheet using explosive expansion repair process).

However, in a letter dated April 19, 1983, the licensee withdrew the February 2 request and plans to resubmit the license amendment after the "Sholly" regulations become effective on May 6, 1983. The licensee believes that it is in the interest of all concerned that the new regulations, including their provisions for public comment and State consultation on proposed significant hazards determinations be applied to the steam generator amendment request.
