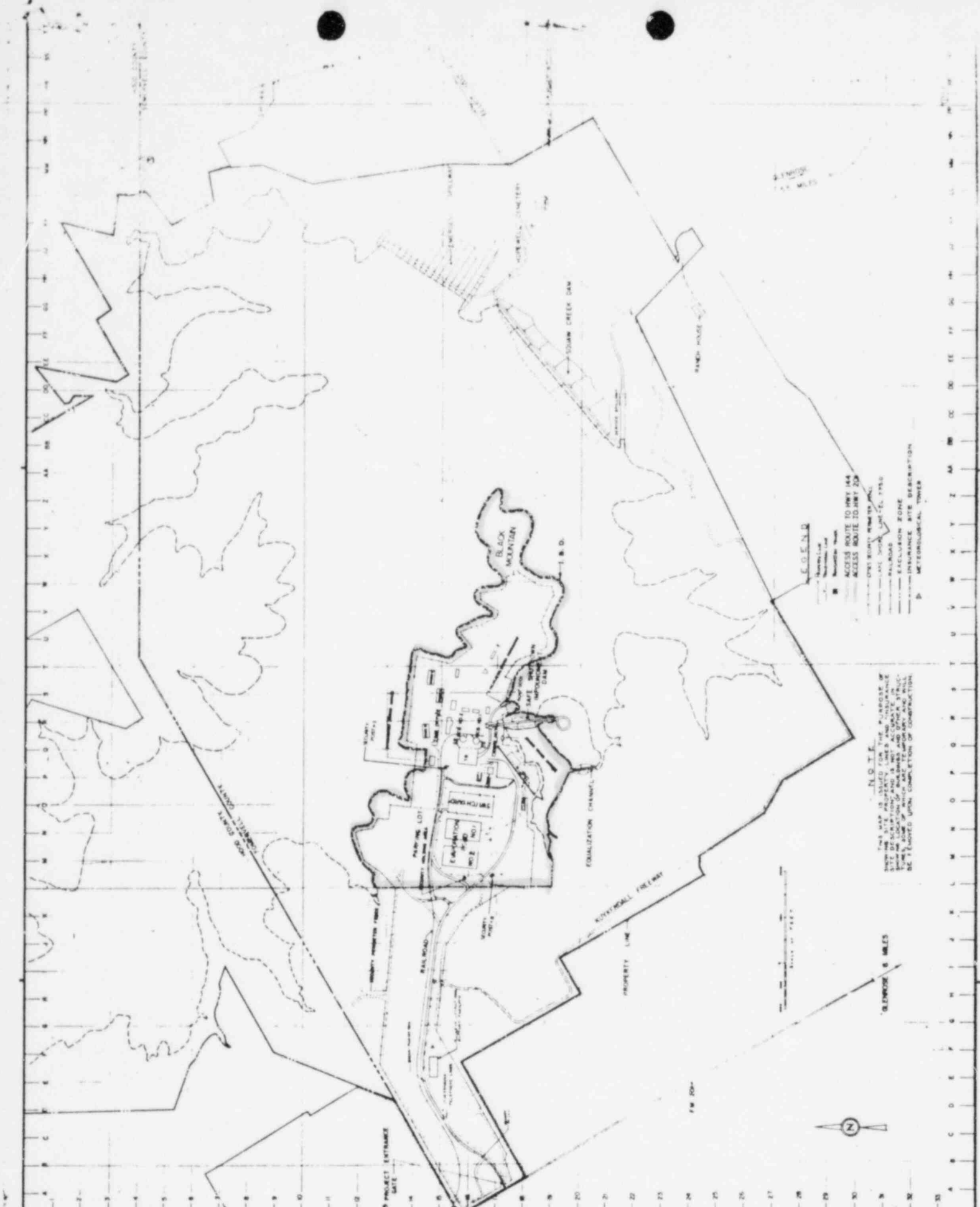


AMENDMENT OF THE DESCRIPTION OF THE FACILITY ENDORSEMENT


