Subject: Schedule for Meeting Emergency Response Capability Requirements
for the Limerick Plant

We have reviewed your April 15, 1983 letter which transmitted a proposed schedule for satisfying the requirements in Supplement No. 1 to NUREG-0737, "Requirements for Emergency Response Capability (Generic Letter No. 82-33)" dated December 17, 1982.

We have discussed this schedule by telephone with your representatives and have reached agreement on a final schedule which provides for implementation of these important improvements prior to fuel load, taking into consideration efficient use of your resources and ours. The final schedule is enclosed.

It is important that these dates be met. However, if you find that you cannot meet these dates because of circumstances beyond your control, you should telephone the Licensing Project Manager, L. L. Kintner.
