Dear Mr. Cook:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. M. J. Miller, F. L. Brush, and D. E. Hills of this office on December 6, 1994 through January 17, 1995. The inspection included a review of authorized activities for your Clinton Power Station facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations of activities in progress, and interviews with personnel.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements. However, the violation will not be subject to enforcement action because your efforts in identifying and correcting the violation meet the criteria specified in Section VII.B of the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," (Enforcement Policy, 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C (1994)). We are concerned, however, that there is an apparent adverse trend involving plant staff inattention to detail in the conduct of work activities. I encourage you to determine and address underlying fundamental causes to prevent related occurrences.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
