SUBJECT: NOTES FROM CHAIRMAN'S OCTOBER 20, 1994 MEETING WITH
CENTERIOR ENERGY CORPORATION REPRESENTATIVES

The Chairman met with Messrs. Donald Shelton, Senior Vice President and James Kloosterman, Manager of Regulatory Affairs, at their request, to discuss current issues and plans relative to the Perry Nuclear Power Plant and Davis Besse Nuclear Power Station.

Mr. Shelton reviewed the efforts being made to improve personnel and plant performance at the Perry Nuclear Power Plant. He identified that progress had been made in improving the material condition of the plant as a result of the extended refueling outage. However, Mr. Shelton noted that additional improvements would require appreciable enhancement of the work control process and greater personnel accountability. Concerns were also identified over the size of the backlogs in several areas. Changes to the work control process were being directed to improving its efficiency which should result in reducing the backlogs. It was noted that the increasing backlogs indicated that plant personnel were better identifying plant material problems and process weaknesses.

Dr. Selin questioned the effect the transfer of resources (management personnel) had on the operation of Davis Besse. Mr. Shelton indicated that the plant and personnel performance at Davis Besse has remained very good.
