Dear Mr. DeLaBarre:

Enclosed is an application for an export license (XSNM02852), recently received by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, for the export of UF<sub>6</sub> for fuel fabrication purposes and use in light water power reactors in EURATOM countries and the United States. Assurances from EURATOM are required that the material will be subject to all of the terms and conditions of the EURATOM agreement for cooperation. Your assistance in obtaining the necessary assurances will be appreciated.

You will note that the applicant has requested license validity for five years. We would appreciate Executive Branch comments regarding a license validity date which extends beyond the Agreement for Cooperation expiration date, which for EURATOM, is December 31, 1995.

Please note that the applicant expects that the proposed exports may contain material of Australian and Canadian origin.
