
SUBJECT: GROUP OF EXPERTS UNDER CSNI PRINCIPAL WORKING GROUP 4

I received your January 31 memo recommending Sarbes Acharya for the Group of Experts on Accident Consequences. Travel funding will be a problem not only in this group but in other PWG sub-groups as well. After we get an understanding of the relative priority of these groups and our greater or lesser interests in particular meetings, we may wish to meet with Bill Dircks to develop some way to allow some trips by NRC members to sub-PWG meetings. In the meantime, I would encourage Acharya to call Paris to introduce himself to the person on the NEA Secretariat who will work with the Group of Experts on Accident Consequences and to discuss how Acharya might contribute to their work without attending the meeting on March 9-11.

I have not received Mel Silberberg's recommendations on the other two PWG 4 groups of experts. When I have all three names, I will inform the NEA through formal channels.

I am enclosing announcements of the first meetings of the three groups of experts. You and Mel have probably received your own copies directly.
