10 CFR 71, Subpart D - Application for Trojan Steam Generator Package Approval

In accordance with 10 CFR 71, this letter provides Portland General Electric's (PGE's) application to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for approval authorizing use of the Trojan Nuclear Plant steam generators as radioactive material transportation packages. The enclosure to this letter, "Trojan Nuclear Plant Safety Analysis Report for Steam Generator Packages," has been completed in accordance with 10 CFR 71, Subpart D, demonstrating that the design of the packages satisfies the package approval standards contained in Subpart E.

In accordance with the quality assurance requirements of 10 CFR 71, Subpart H, the design, fabrication, and use of packaging for radioactive material is covered by Trojan's NRC-approved quality assurance program (PGE-8010) which satisfies the applicable criteria of 10 CFR 50, Appendix B. PGE-8010, "Trojan Nuclear Plant Nuclear Quality Assurance Program," was approved by the NRC for application to design, fabrication, assembly, and modification of transportation packages by Quality Assurance Program Approval for Radioactive Material Packages No. 0327, Revision No. 7, dated December 22, 1994.

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
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As discussed in a meeting between representatives of PGE and NRC on January 12, 1995, PGE requests package approval as early as practicable in June 1995 to support the large component removal project currently underway at the Trojan plant. PGE recognizes that this schedule is ambitious, and is prepared to provide any necessary assistance in support of the NRC's review.
