SUBJECT: ERRATA TO REVISION 1 OF THE AP600 SSAR

Dear Mr. Borchardt:

Enclosed is errata for revision 1 of the AP600 Standard Safety Analysis Report (SSAR). The errata is in the form of replacement pages and sections to be inserted into the existing binders to replace superseded pages. Revision 1 of the SSAR was transmitted on January 13, 1994 with letter NTD-NRC-94-4039. The pages are provided to correct page numbers and header information, correct figure titles, improve figure image quality, and correct the list of effective pages. No technical information has been changed. Additionally, separation tabs have been provided for sections added in revision 1.

Thirty-six sets have been sent to Rick Hasselberg. Included with each set are change page instructions and a list of effective pages. Eight sets are being shipped directly to ACRS members. Thirteen sets are being shipped directly to NRC subcontractors.

Westinghouse recognizes that prior to issuance of the AP600 Final Design Approval in September 1996, the amount of proprietary information in the AP600 SSAR must be reduced to support development of the Design Control Document that will form the basis of the certified design. To that end, the proprietary information in the AP600 SSAR will be reviewed as a part of the ongoing SSAR update process.

The Westinghouse Electric Corporation copyright notice, proprietary information notice, application for withholding and affidavit are attached.

This submittal contains Westinghouse proprietary information consisting of trade secrets, commercial information or financial information which we consider privileged or confidential pursuant to 10CFR9.17(a)(4). Therefore, it is requested that the Westinghouse proprietary information attached hereto be handled on a confidential basis and be withheld from public disclosures. This proprietary information is contained in separate volumes of the SSAR report.
