SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING THE REVIEW OF INDIVIDUAL PLANT EXAMINATION SUBMITTAL (TAC NOS. M74387 AND M74388)

Gentlemen:

The purpose of this letter is document telephone conversations held with the members of the Nuclear Regulatory Commision (NRC) on November 22, 1994 regarding the NRC's request for additional information dated November 9, 1994. The November 9, 1994 letter requested, within 60 days of receipt, that additional information be provided to support the NRC's review of Carolina Power & Light Company's August 31, 1992 response to Generic Letter 88-20, "Individual Plant Examination For Severe Accident Vulnerabilities — 10 CFR 50.54(f)."

Based on information discussed by CP&L during the November 22, 1994 telephone call, the NRC agreed to provide CP&L with an additional 45 days to provide the requested information. Accordingly, CP&L now plans to submit the requested response on or before February 28, 1995.
