The staff is in receipt of your letter dated September 6, 1983, regarding a request for extension of time of the 60-day response time that licensees and applicants were given to request an extension for submittal of the information requested in Generic Letter 83-28. The staff, when writing Generic Letter 83-28, did not intend or allow for requests for an extension of the 60-day response. In fact, in order to allow the staff to plan reviews and ensure timely implementation, we believe a general overall status regarding the industry posture is warranted and therefore we are not granting any requests for an extension from licensees or near-term operating reactor license applicants.

However, based on the fact that your facility will not be operating in the near future, the staff will grant an extension of the 120 day response until April 1, 1984.

This request for information was previously approved by the Office of Management and Budget under clearance number 3150-0011 which expires April 30, 1985.

In fact, in order to allow the staff to plan reviews and ensure timely implementation, we believe a general overall status regarding the industry posture is warranted and therefore we are not granting any requests for an extension from licensees or near-term operating reactor license applicants.

We therefore, request that you submit the information requested, to the extent practical, by November 5, 1983. Where commitments and schedules for final implementation are possible they should be provided. Where additional planning is needed, before the final implementation schedules can be established, you should provide a description of your plans and schedules for developing the program in question.

The Salem ATWS Events have far reaching safety implications. For those issues requiring long range planning we believe that your participation with an owners groups, INPO or other industry group is desirable and commendable, however, it is important that the staff be able to assess the status of the industry response regarding the implementation of the required actions, as soon as possible.

This request for information was previously approved by the Office of Management and Budget under clearance number 3150-0011 which expires April 30, 1985.
