

SUBJECT: VISIT OF MR. STULLER TO NRC TO APRIL 5, 1993

Mr. Jan Stuller, who is the new head of the Czech Republic's State Organization for Nuclear Safety (SONS), accompanied by Dr. Hrehor, Director for Administration, will visit NRC on April 5. One of the first tasks Mr. Stuller has been given is to cut his agency's staffing level by about 50% to roughly 50 people.

Mr. Stuller spent six months (6/92-12/92) on assignment in AEOD from the Czechoslovak Atomic Energy (CSAEC). He would like NRC to advise him on organization and staffing priorities so he can carry out his responsibilities with an NRC-like approach. In other words, he would like guidance on how we determine the number of people/contractors it takes to do the job. He is not looking for a discussion of what we do, but how we accomplish our responsibilities, and would like senior staff to guide him so that he can determine if he has to go back and indicate that more staff and/or money will be needed to accomplish his organization's mission. He has provided the attached organizational charts, proposed staffing levels, and responsibilities assigned to the new regulatory organization. He has three major technical departments: Department of Components and Systems, Department of Nuclear Materials, and Department of Nuclear Safety Assessment. The Czech Republic now has four VVER-230 reactors in operation and two VVER-1000 reactors under construction.

Please let me know by April 1 who will be available to meet with Mr. Stuller and Dr. Hrehor. The meeting will start at 8:30 a.m. in Room 1-F-5 (see other dates for specific rooms). A tentative schedule is attached for your information and use. If you feel less time is needed to brief Mr. Stuller, please provide us with a revised schedule.

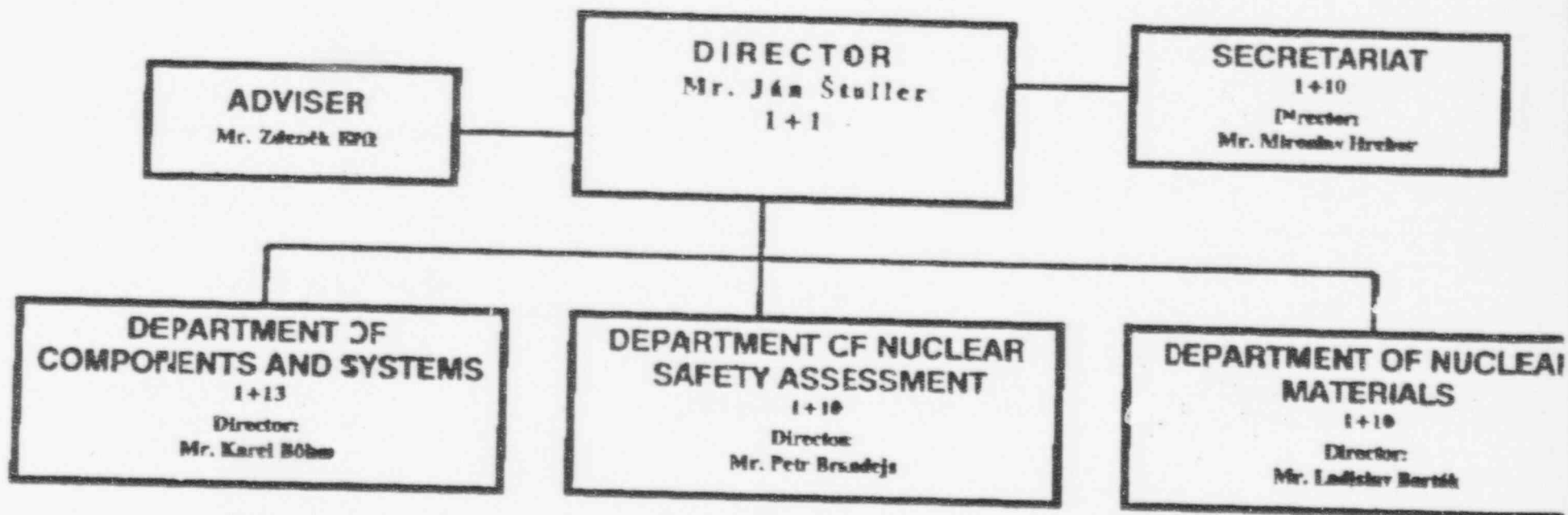
