Subject: TRANSPORT OF INJURED EMPLOYEE

On December 22, 1994, an Unusual Event was declared at 12:55 a.m., at the McGuire nuclear station due to the transport by ambulance of a potentially contaminated, injured employee to a nearby medical facility. The employee had been performing general outage related cleaning activities inside the Unit 2 containment when he fell 8 feet from a ladder. The employee suffered non-life threatening injuries to his head, shoulders and neck. Station health physics personnel accompanied the injured employee to Carolina Medical Center. Surveys performed by health physics personnel verified that no contamination was present. The resident inspectors were notified. There has been no media interest.

The unusual Event was terminated at 2:25 a.m.

The licensee notified local and state agencies.

No press release was issued by the licensee.
