One of the clinical laboratories here at Hutzel Hospital doing RIA wants to move one of their work areas.

Attached is a memo from the laboratory manager that summarizes the proposed changes. Basically, the request is to move the RIA work area from one room to the corner of another room. There will be some non-RIA work performed in the same room.

Since: a) the proposed work area will be in the corner, b) the levels of radionuclide on hand and/or in storage at any one time are well below amounts allowed on our license, c) the area will be posted with the appropriate warning signs and d) more than adequate storage space is available in that area, then will it be acceptable to the NRC to allow for Mr. Demman to make the change?

Dear, Mr. Buchel.

The clinical laboratory department has undergone an incredible downsizing concerning RIA procedures in the last couple of years, and this turn of events has raised some questions that need answering.

Storage:

Presently the maximum volume and total ^{micro}microcuries of test kits under storage in our refrigerator is:

- α Feto protein-Kallestad 5 kits 34.5mCi each
 - β HCG-Leeco 10 kits 10mCi each
- Total mCi on site at any one time is 273mCi.

Testing Areas Requirements:

Because of the low volume testing currently being done, are there any specifications required as to minimum work space regulations etc. air exchange requirements, radioactive monitoring regulations etc.

Security Requirements:

Does the storage of test kits require that they be secured if the room is accessible at all times?

Does the work space have to be secured especially if other non-RIA functions are performed in the same area?

Thank you for your anticipated help in this matter, and I'll be hoping to hear from you in the near future.
