Gentlemen:

In our letter of April 24, 1991, we advised you of an electrical distribution system functional inspection (EDSFI) to be performed at the Cooper Nuclear Station (CNS) during July and August 1991. This letter is to advise you of changes in the planned inspection schedule and confirms the telephone conversation between Mr. William Swantz of your staff and Mr. Tom McKernon of this office on May 13, 1991.

The current schedule for the EDSFI is as follows:

1. During the week of July 15, 1991, the team will conduct a preparatory trip to the NPPD corporate office and a site visit to the CNS facility. The team desires to conduct an entrance meeting at 2 p.m. on July 15, 1991, at your corporate office. During our visit at the corporate office, we will discuss the interfaces between the team and your staff and identify the design documents needed by the team.
2. The site visit on July 16-17, 1991, will be utilized to provide training to the regional inspectors requiring badging for unescorted access. This period will also be used to obtain plant procedures and other documentation to support the EDSFI effort.
3. The first week of the inspection will be conducted during the week of July 29, 1991. During this first week, part of the inspection team will be located at your corporate office in Columbus and the rest of the team will be at the CNS site.
4. The second week of the inspection will be conducted during the week of August 12, 1991. For the second week of the inspection, the entire team will be located at the site. Since the consultants will not be badged for unescorted access, we request locating the inspection team outside the protected area while at the CNS site.

An exit meeting will be scheduled at the site for the morning of the final day of inspection, August 16, 1991. The team leader will conduct daily debriefings
