

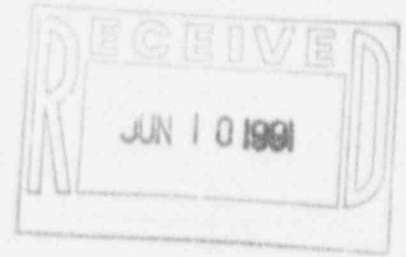
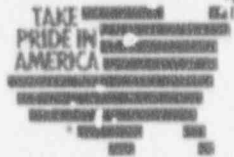

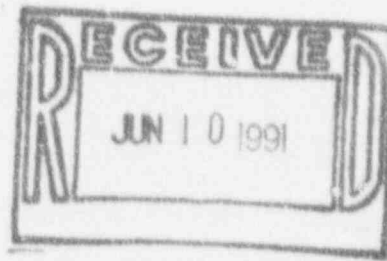

This letter is in response to your request for additional information for the items listed below:

Violations E.1 and 2

A semi-annual inspection of the logging equipment was completed on February 19, 1991. The last semi-annual management review was conducted on March 6, 1991.

Management Oversight

Oversight of program activities and the importance of complying with all Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requirements has been emphasized to the newly assigned Management Representative, Dave Wilkins. Although Mr. Wilkins has received training on "Radiation Safety in Well Operations" other training is scheduled to provide him with a good understanding of the procedures that employees must follow to decrease the health risk in handling licensed material. In addition, our Logging Program will receive a quarterly review by the District Chief, Associate District Chief, and Assistant District Chief in discussion with Dave Wilkins, James Basler, and R.K. Dewees.


