REMARKS

RE: Demand for Information + AIT For SEQUOYAH FUELS

Although staff allowed restart of Sequoyah fuels (SFC) after detection of uranium contamination in groundwater and soils, the AIT + OI investigations have developed information that causes staff to question SFC's commitment to safety + environmental protection. Some of the same individuals involved here were also involved in the 1986 accident at the Gore, Okla. facility. Staff intent in issuing the Demand is to "get the licensee's attention" without providing any hearing rights. The licensee has still not closed out the order issued in September. OI's interviews are completed; verbal report provided to EDO on 10/18/90; AT report is due by 2/91. Looks reasonable to us.
