Dear Mr. White:

I am responding to your letter of April 8, 1991, expressing concern about certain staff conclusions regarding a Nuclear Safety Review Staff report on Corrective Action at TVA and your testimony before the Commission.

We acknowledge that the April 30, 1987 Nuclear Manager's Review Group (NMRG) report was issued. That report did state that an earlier report prepared by the Nuclear Safety Review staff was never completed or released, but rather the issues raised in it were considered in the NMRG effort.

With respect to your concern with the staff's statement that you made statements similar to those of Mr. Sanger, who was found to have made a willful material false statement, your position on whether the statements were "similar" is well laid out in your letter of October 10, 1990. I believe Mr. Crutchfield's letter of February 1, 1990, makes quite clear that notwithstanding any "similarities" between your statements and those of Mr. Sanger, the NRC staff did not conclude that you knowingly provided false information to NRC.

I trust this concludes this matter.
