Dear Ms. Brink:

I am responding to your petition of November 20, 1990, submitted on behalf of Citizens for Fair Utility Regulation, requesting that action be taken with respect to the Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station.

Your request was referred to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff in accordance with Section 2.206 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR 2.206). For the reasons stated in the enclosed Director's Decision (DD-91-05), there is no adequate basis in your Petition for taking the action which you have requested. Due to the nature of allegations raised in the Petition, a copy of the Petition was provided to the NRC Inspector General (IG) on December 24, 1990, for any action the IG considered appropriate.

A copy of this Decision will be filed with the Secretary of the Commission for the Commission to review in accordance with 10 CFR 2.206(c). As provided for in this regulation, the Decision will constitute the final action of the Commission 25 days after the date of issuance of the Decision unless the Commission, on its own motion, institutes a review of the Decision within that time.
