Gentlemen:

This refers to the telephone conversation between yourself and Mr. James H. Joyner of my staff on January 13, 1984, regarding the results of the inspection of your facility on January 11, 1984.

With regard to this matter, we understand that you have taken the following action:

All isotope radiography in any permanent radiographic facility not equipped with the visible and audible warning signals required by 10 CFR 34.29 has been discontinued and will not be resumed until such time as the permanent facility complies in all respects with NRC requirements.

If our understanding of your planned action, as described above, is not in accordance with the actions being implemented, please contact this office by telephone and in writing within 24 hours of your receipt of this letter.

This also confirms that an Enforcement Conference will be conducted in our Region I office in King of Prussia, Pennsylvania, on January 31, 1984, at 10:00 a.m. to discuss the violations of NRC requirements identified during the January 11 inspection. At the Enforcement Conference you should be prepared to discuss the cause(s) of the violations and your proposed corrective action. A copy of our inspection report will be provided to you under separate cover.

No reply to this letter is required. Your cooperation with us is appreciated.
