Gentlemen:

Thank you for your letter of September 22, 1983, in response to our letter dated July 22, 1983. I have discussed your response with the inspector who performed the inspection of your facility. He informs me that when he contacted you to determine whether electrical components/equipment for nuclear plants had been or were presently being irradiated at your facility, he was informed that safety-related components had been irradiated in the past and, at that time, you had a request for proposal for nuclear work. Further, I understand that the NRC was encouraged or invited to review your QA program because you expected to receive the contract for such work and continue doing such work in the future.

We now understand that you did not receive the contract and have no nuclear work (10 CFR Part 50, Appendix B and 10 CFR Part 21 requirements). Since this is the case, there is no 10 CFR Part 21 violation and no need to provide a response.

Several nonconformances with respect to your quality assurance program were identified during the subject inspection and documented in Inspection Report No. 83-01. If you plan to do no nuclear work in the future, there is no need to respond to the subject notice of nonconformance; however, if you do plan to do nuclear work, please respond to the notice of nonconformance as requested in our letter.

Should you have any further questions concerning this inspection, we will be pleased to discuss them with you.
