Dear Mr. Healy:

I am responding to your July 16, 1991 request for termination of your nuclear materials license. Your request was also forwarded to the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission through Senator Edward M. Kennedy's office. As indicated in the enclosed copy of your license amendment, your NRC license was terminated on August 22, 1991.

We appreciate your concern for the increased fees. However, Public Law 101-508, the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990, requires that the Commission recover 100 percent of its budget authority, less appropriations from the Nuclear Waste Fund, for Fiscal Years 1991 through 1995 by assessing license and annual fees. For FY 1991, the Commission must collect approximately \$445 million by September 30, 1991 through these fees. To implement this law, proposed regulations were published in the Federal Register on April 12, 1991. Based on a careful evaluation of over 400 public comments, the Commission changed the proposed rule, and published a final rule on July 10, 1991. In establishing the annual fees, the Commission has followed the Congressional guidance that costs relating to a specific class of licensees should be assessed to that class.

Your cooperation with us is appreciated.
