This is in regard to the petition for rulemaking you filed with the Commission on behalf of the General Electric Company. In the petition, which was filed jointly with the Westinghouse Corporation, you requested that the Commission issue a rule that would provide a means for the self-guarantee of decommissioning funding costs by certain NRC licensees who meet stringent financial assurance and related reporting and oversight requirements.

Your petition has been docketed pursuant to 10 CFR 2.802 to recognize your request for amendment of the Commission's regulations. The petition has been assigned Docket Number PRM-30-59.
