Dear Sir:


NRC Generic Letter 89-04 requires licensees to submit all open relief requests for NRC review (References 1 and 2). The Authority submitted the status of all relief requests for the James A. FitzPatrick Nuclear Power Plant as Attachment II to NYPA letter JPN-91-054, dated September 27, 1991 (Reference 3).

The Authority requests that the NRC review the open relief requests by January 1, 1992 because the Authority wants to implement Revision 4 of the IST program during the next FitzPatrick refueling outage which is scheduled for January 10, 1992. Prompt NRC staff approval is requested so that any necessary changes may be made to the program's procedures. The Authority may not be able to revise the procedures prior to the 1992 refueling outage, if NRC comments are received after January 1, 1992.
