Subject: Modification of Maine Yankee Technical Specifications Concerning
Audits of the Facility Emergency and Security Plans

Dear Sir:

In accordance with Section 50.59 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Maine Yankee Atomic Power Company proposes the following Modification to Appendix A of Operating License DPR-36 issued for the Maine Yankee plant. We propose to modify these specifications as follows:

- A. Replace page 5.5-5 of Specification 5.5 with the enclosed revised page 5.5-5.

This change revises the frequency for performing independent audits of the Facility Emergency and Security Plans and implementing procedures from every 24 months to every 12 months in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(t) and 10 CFR 50.54 (p).

This change is deemed not to involve an unreviewed safety question as described in 10 CFR 50.59 and has been reviewed by the Plant Operations Review Committee and the Nuclear Safety and Audit Review Committee.


