The Putnam County Legislature is concerned with the transportation of nuclear waste in and through our County.


As you might know, we are located very close to the Indian Point complex. The Legislature has been discussing the possibility of passing a Local Law on the transportation of nuclear waste.

We have written to the New York State Police, the Department of Transportation and FEMA with reference to whether there are specific rules on who is to be notified when the transportation of nuclear waste passes from each of the Counties.
