Upon consideration of the January 25, 1984 Suggestion of Mooney
filed by the parties to this proceeding and the recitation therein of
the terms of settlement, namely:

3. Under the terms of the settlement the Licensee will file
a new or amended application for an amendment to its operating
license to permit one loop operation at power levels up to but not
exceeding 50% of full power. The Staff will then review that
application to assure that among other things the technical
specifications if amended as requested will limit one loop
operation to power levels of no more than 50% of full power. Mr.
Doherty has agreed not to oppose issuance of such an amendment to
the Licensee's Operating License.;




