ORDER CONFIRMING SCHEDULE CHANGES

During the hearing of Group I contentions on January 27, 1984 at Riverhead, Long Island, the Board and parties discussed, inter alia, the following: anticipated date of completion of FEMA's RAC review and availability of FEMA testimony; LILCO discovery of New York State witnesses and date for completion of Group I testimony; and possible changes in schedule leading to commencement of hearing on Group II issues. Stewart M. Glass, Esq., Counsel for FEMA, stated that FEMA expects to submit its RAC review to the NRC by February 7, 1984 and that FEMA would need three weeks thereafter to prepare and file its testimony. Thereafter, all parties submitted their views on scheduling and the Board considered those views and changed the schedule.


