Attorney for the Southern District of Texas in the Department of Justice, on February 1, 1994, in reference to the Office of Investigations' report regarding harassment and intimidation of a contract instrumentation and control technician. Mr. Shelby stated he had no objection to restart. It was his understanding that the staff had addressed the associated technical issues and the restart of STP should not be affected by his continued inquiry.
