NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of the inspection conducted on October 12, 1983, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR 2, Appendix C), the following violation were identified:

10 CFR 34.29(b) requires that each entrance used for personnel access to the high radiation area in a permanent radiographic installation have both visible and audible warning signals to warn of the presence of radiation. The visible signal is required to be actuated by radiation whenever the source is exposed and the audible signal is required to be actuated when an attempt is made to enter the installation while the source is exposed.

Contrary to the above, on October 12, 1983, the audible alarm on the cobalt-60 permanent radiographic installation's Lead Room #2 failed to sound when tested with a radiographic source.

This is a Severity Level IV violation. (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, General Dynamics Corporation Electric Boat Division is hereby required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of the letter which transmitted this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending this response time.
